California Community Colleges Library Services Platform (LSP) Request for Information (RFI)

Library Services Platform Project Description

On behalf of the 114 California community college libraries, the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO) and the CCC Technology Center (CCCTC) are initiating a state-funded project to obtain a single cloud-based library services platform (LSP) to replace the various ILS systems now in use in any of the 114 libraries which choose to participate. The CCCCCO and the CCCTC will partner with the Council of Chief Librarians, California Community College (CCL) to form project governance, develop a project workplan, select representative pilot colleges and complete the procurement process. Once an LSP vendor is chosen and contracted, the project team, CCL and other stakeholders will work with the vendor to assure a successful implementation across the system.

Procurement Objective

This RFI is part of a procurement process that will result in the purchase of a cloud-based Library Services Platform (LSP) and related support services to be deployed and used by the community colleges in California. The objective of this RFI is to identify and explore capabilities and practices of vendors that may be viable providers of products or services necessary to support a LSP for use among the California Community Colleges. Additionally, this RFI process will inform the development of a Request for Proposal (RFP) for a LSP. Information given in the RFI will not be used to pre-qualify vendors for the RFP.

Through the RFI process, CCCTC is looking for features and capabilities that will help specify a *state of the art* cloud-based LSP for use by the 114 colleges in the California Community College system. Interested parties that meet the requirements listed in this document are encouraged to submit responses regarding products and related service offerings. The CCCTC may conduct discussions with specific vendors and other applicants who have submitted responses if there are questions regarding the subject matter requested in the RFI.

All information should be submitted in the format stipulated in this RFI via RFP365. This is not an offer to buy, nor obligation to purchase, on the part of the California Community College Chancellor's Office, the CCC Tech Center, or any individual community college. Mandatory requirements (Tentative)

A full set of mandatory and desired requirements for the LSP system will be included in the RFP. At a minimum, the chosen partner must meet the following requirements:

- Be able to scale up to implement and support all 114 community colleges.
- Have significant experience hosting LSP applications including supporting a large customer / client base of colleges / universities.
- Be willing to work with the California Community Colleges Technology Center in developing future enhancements to the system to meet CCC requirements.
- Meet Section 508 (29 U.S.C. § 794d)/WCAG 2.0 AA regulations for facilitating access for individuals with disabilities
- Vendor must show support for NIST 800-171 Security Standards as well as SAML compatible Single Sign-On
