AB 928 – Auto-ADT LOCAL PROGRAM MANDATE

Adjusted Education Code Section 66749.8 to include:

- Student declare a goal of transfer AND
- An Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) exists for their declared major
- Must place that student on that ADT pathway in the student education plan (SEP)

Exceptions:

California Community Colleges

- An ADT pathway does not exist in the chosen major at the college.
- The student's educational pathway is better served by a local associate degree.
- The student plans to apply to transfer to a UC campus or an independent college or university.
- The student is seeking to complete a **community college** baccalaureate degree program.
- The student is seeking to complete a career technical education program that does not have an ADT pathway.

Implementation Timing

- On or before August 1, 2024
- Newly enrolled students
 - Beginning with late Summer and Fall 2024 new students
 - Establish a protocol to mark the SEP and identify opt-out exceptions
- On or after August 1, 2024
- Continuing students
 - Switch their education goal to transfer OR change their major and all other parameters prevail, then they would need to be placed on the appropriate ADT pathway.
 - Encourage counselor visit to mitigate any contraindicated missteps
- Guidance memo: ESS 23-41, 9/25/23
- Joint Funding memo: <u>ESS 23-48</u>, 12/14/23





Student selects Transfer with Degree for Ed Goal

Decision Point 1

Display of Majors

CCC degree functions available

- local naming conventions
- some ordering of list display

Adjustment Options:

 ADTs only (thru a ward type field when defining majors in admin portal)

Categories (optional)

- Align with available degrees
- Programmed to hideif no degrees available

Choice here may require special attention to program inputs & will impact subsequent process decisions.

Provided to Student

Education Goal

Transfer with Degree

Major Listing Display

(New CCCApply major award type filter)

- AATs/ASTs & AAs/ASs only
- Will sort ADTs first
- Alphabetical

Decision Point 1 major display adjustments shown here.

Decision Point 2

Student Account

From CCCApply data including Ed Goal and Major elements

Automate for ADT placement dependent upon major choice

Abbreviated SEP Option

Prepopulate with degree requirements when student account is created

May require application programming

- prepare for counselor visit
- for independent student

Comprehensive SEP

Counselor Visit

Include any steps if do not have abbreviated SEP option

Document proper ADT placement

Allow for individualizing a transfer pathway and course-taking decisions

Decision Point 3

Exceptions

Provide reference options for statutory compliance & a fully designed ed plan

Program into education planning application for ease and validation



CCCApply Support for AB928 Provision

- Displays only Associate Degree majors (ADTs & ADs) when student selects Education Goal #1
 - Obtain an Associate degree and transfer to a 4-year institution
 - Helps prevent selection of the wrong program
- Open, all-colleges pilot release on April 12, 2024
- "Go Live" Production Release on April 26, 2024

Ed Goal/Majors Filter for Associate Degrees

- Filter off by default
- When enabled, only applies to education goal #1

 <edu_goal = A> "Obtain an Associate degree and transfer to a 4-year institution."
 - When student selects Ed Goal #1, only majors with the following award types display:
 - AA-T, AS-T, AA, AS
 - Only major categories with one or more ADTs or AAs will display



Ed Goal/Majors Filter for Associate Degrees

- When a student selects any other Ed Goal (NOT Ed Goal #1)
 - Majors and major categories display alphabetically without any filtering on the Award Type
 - Current business logic



Steps to Implement

- Review college use of Award Types in setting up Majors
 - Update Award Type configurations if planning to enable filtering by Ed Goal #1 & ADT/AA award types
- Review Major descriptions
 - Majors display alphabetically within Award Type
- Set up pilot environment as planned & enable filtering in pilot (target pilot date is April 12, 2024)
 - Test new major settings and filter in pilot
- Update production settings to match pilot
- Enable the filter in production
