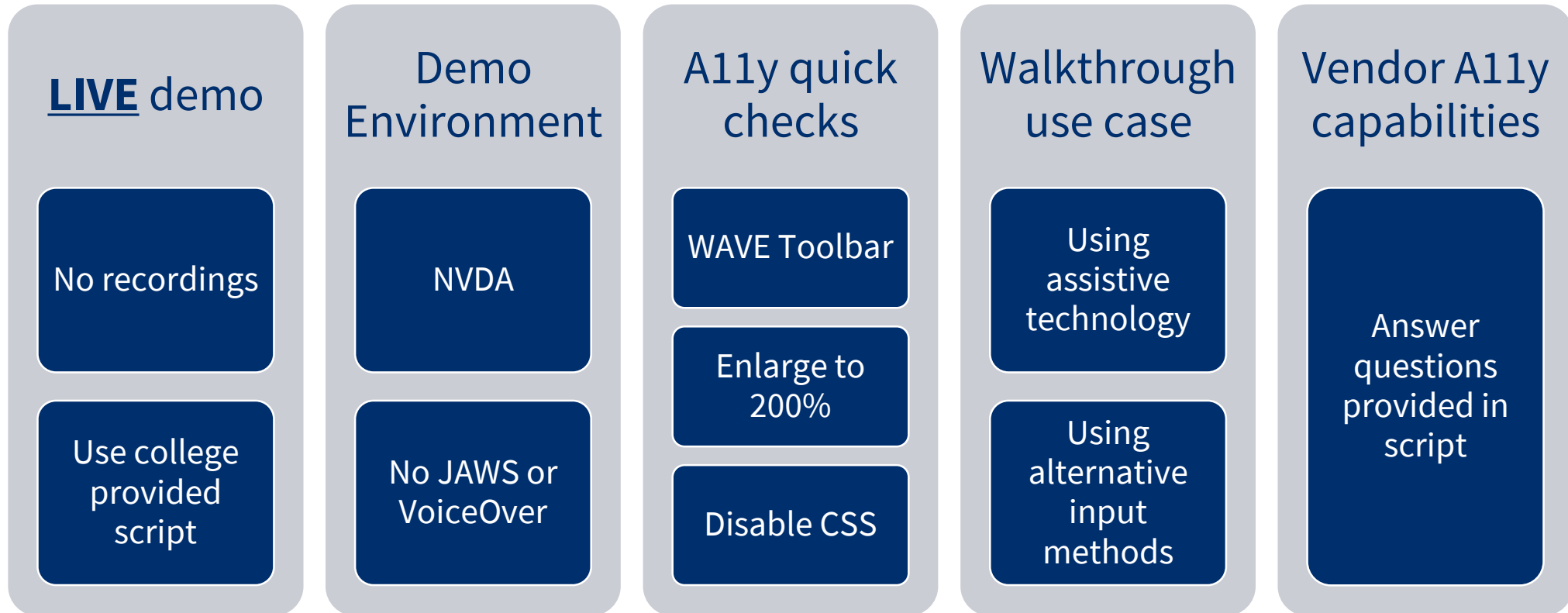

Preparing for Demo

College Prep for Demo

Determine functionality to be demoed

Develop Use Cases

Ensure knowledgeable moderator and notetaker are available

Invite Key College Stakeholders to Demo

Vendor Prep for Demo

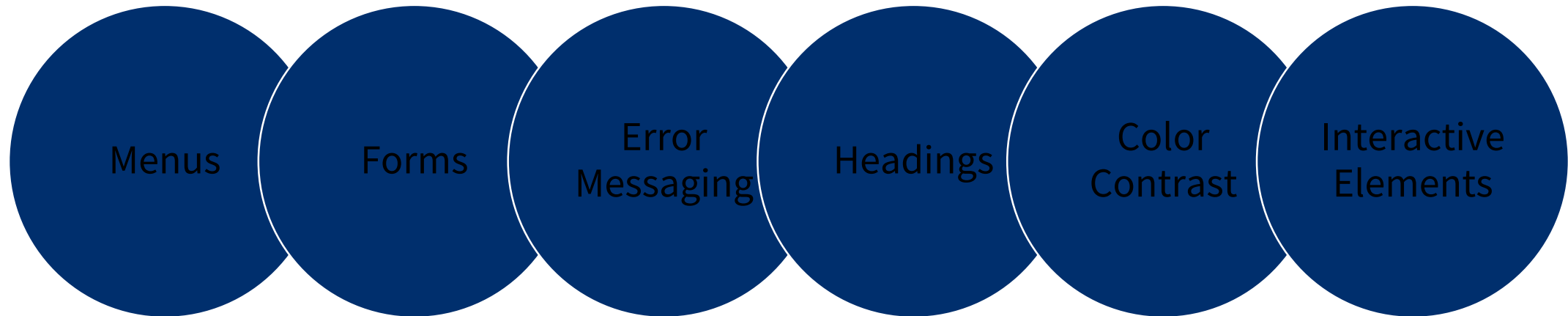
Review college provided demo script

Identify staff to conduct demo

Install required technology on demo workstation

Be prepared to answer questions from script

UI Elements to Evaluate



Live Demo - Steps

- Use WAVE evaluation tool
- Raise text size to 200%
- Disable style sheets
- Use Case using keyboard only
- Use Case using Screen Reader
